

THE PASSING of HOWARD LOVE Former ULSA CEO



It is with great sadness to convey the final transition of Howard Love - former President / CEO of the Urban League of Arkansas

HOWARD LOVE BECAME CHIEF EXECUTIVE IN 1970 WHERE THE ORGANIZATION UNDERWENT A NAME CHANGE TO THE URBAN LEAGUE OF ARKANSAS, INC. (ULA). THE CHANGE REFLECTED THE AMBITIONS OF THE ORGANIZATION TO HAVE MORE OF A STATEWIDE REACH, ALTHOUGH IN REALITY MOST OF ITS ACTIVITIES STILL FOCUSED ON THE CENTRAL ARKANSAS AREA AROUND LITTLE ROCK.

DURING HIS TENURE, LOVE TACKLED ISSUES SUCH AS FAIR HOUSING ACCESS FOR BLACK CITIZENS, AFFIRMATIVE ACTION PROGRAMS TO INCREASE BLACK EMPLOYMENT IN PREVIOUSLY LIMITED AREAS SUCH AS LAW ENFORCEMENT, THE ADVENT OF BUSING IN THE LITTLE ROCK SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND BLACK MEDICAL AND HEALTH ISSUES. IN 1977, A FIRE AT ULA OFFICES DESTROYED MOST OF ITS LOCAL INSTITUTIONAL RECORDS. IT SUBSEQUENTLY MOVED ITS HEADQUARTERS TO 2200 SOUTH MAIN STREET.

IN 1987, ULA CELEBRATED ITS FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF CONTINUOUS OPERATION.
MR. LOVE WILL BE MISSED AND GREATLY APPRECIATED FOR HIS LEADERSHIP OF AND CONTRIBUTIONS
TO THE URBAN LEAGUE OF ARKANSAS AND THE CITIZENS SERVED BY OUR ORGANIZATION.


DISCONNECTED YOUTH

The Urban Youth Empowerment Program uses a holistic approach to prepare Opportunity Youth for pathways to economic stability through a comprehensive set of services, including:


- Career readiness and placement
